About us

Nottingham Language Academy is located in The Park area of central Nottingham. We offer a wide range of General English courses, exam preparation courses, Summer School for Young Learners, and Work Experience projects, for students of all ages.

We are accredited by The British Council. Accreditation provides students with a guarantee of quality and safety. Accreditation UK, run by the British Council and English UK, is the only internationally-recognised quality assurance scheme for English language schools in the UK.

A comprehensive Safeguarding policy is in place and is reviewed annually. All homestay hosts are carefully chosen before being appointed, and are inspected regularly to ensure the safety of students. All staff members and homestay hosts working with students under 18 are subject to DBS checks and therefore, fit to be working with young learners.

Overview

We will manage the stay of the students, from arrival at your preferred airport, to return to the airport at the end of their stay, providing experienced, local, friendly support and advice throughout.

Fees

We would be happy to provide a very competitive quotation for groups - this can include:

1. Airport transfer

Return airport transfer to your preferred airport. East Midlands airport is 20 minutes to our Academy. Participants will be met by a school representative before onward travel to their homestay accommodation. For return, they will be collected before their journey to the airport

2. Accommodation

Homestay accommodation in either a twin or single room with a host family including, breakfast, packed lunch and evening meal. Students will be located as close as possible to their work placement, – typically 20-30 minutes from the centre of Nottingham, on the City's modern public transport links.

3. Work experience - 1, 2, 3 or 4 weeks

Minimum 30 hours work experience placement per week– comprising an initial 6 hours “Orientation and Introduction to the World of Work” and 24

hours working in a local business. 8 weeks before starting work, we ask the students to complete a short online survey to understand what type of work they would prefer, and to understand their English level. We will then work with our local contacts to find the right business for each student. Health and Safety, employer liability insurance and other suitability checks are carried out on all of our employers. Students will be supported throughout their stay by our dedicated Work Experience Manager, who will be available 24 hours a day during their stay in Nottingham.

4. English support

We can provide English classes to support students' work experience

5. Local transport

We will work with each student to find the fastest public transport option for them in Nottingham - bus or tram - based on their homestay location, workplace, and social plans.

6. Free places for teachers

We can provide free places for teachers that will include full board homestay accommodation in a single room typically 20-30 minutes from the centre of Nottingham, on the City's modern public transport links.

7. Feedback and references from employers

Post trip, the Work Experience Manager will ensure feedback from employers is sent to the students, with references sent from those employers if required.
